


## Product Description



1	USB-A Port	1. Keyboard and Mouse for Console 2. USB Hub for USB peripherals connection
2	Console Video Port	Connect to Monitor(s)
3	Computer USB-B Port	Keyboard and Mouse for computer connection
4	Computer Video Port	Connect to a computer's video card
5	Console Audio Port	Connect to SPK/ MIC (depends on models)
6	Computer Audio Port	Connect to a computer's audio port (depends on models)
7	The Second Monitor Connection	Dual View display (depends on models)
8	Function Button	Adjust video signal strength (depends on models)

## Installation


### Console Connection

1. Plug a monitor into the Console's Video port; plug a USB keyboard and a USB mouse into the corresponding USB ports on the Console.
2. For the model with standard audio feature, plug a set of audio jack from the speaker and microphone to the Console's speaker port and microphone port respectively.
3. Plug USB peripherals into the port USB 1 and/or USB 2 on the Console side if needed

### Computer Connection

1. Use a male-to-male/ female video cable (depends on models) to connect both video ports on the computer and the unit's PC side.
2. Use a USB A-B Cable to connect the unit's USB port (B connector, square connector) and the USB port on the corresponding computer (A connector, flat connector).
3. For the model support audio feature, use a set of audio cable to connect the speaker port and microphone port between the computer side of the unit and the corresponding computer.
4. Plug the power adaptor from an appropriate DC power source to the switch power port


A	Port Selection Button	Press button(s) to select a computer
B	Port Status LED	LEDs light green when the connected computer is powered on
C	Port Select LED	LEDs light red when the connected computer is selected
D	Power LED	Lights when power is on
A	Scan time buttons (4-Port only)	Press button 1 & 2 together to change the scan time interval
A	Auto scan buttons (4-Port only)	Press button 3 & 4 together to start auto scan

## Hotkey Control

Key Sequence	Function
L-Ctrl + L-Ctrl + 1 - 4	Selects the computer at port 1 - 4 (depending on model)
L-Ctrl + L-Ctrl + F1	To start Auto Scan
L-Ctrl + L-Ctrl + F2	To start Manual Scan : Allows users to manually switch back and forth between power-on computers. Press the ▲ or ▼ key to select the previous or the next computer
L-Ctrl + L-Ctrl + F3	To adjust Scan Rate: The KVM Switch generates 1 to 4 beeps indicating duration of scan time for 3, 8, 15 and 30 seconds respectively.
L-Ctrl + L-Ctrl + F7	To turn ON/OFF the USB-Port Rule

**NOTE:** Do not use the keypad on the right of the keyboard.



- Prior to the installation, ensure to power off all devices that will be connected to this system.
- Ensure that all devices you will connect are properly grounded.
- Place cables away from fluorescent lights, air conditioners, and machines that are likely to generate electrical noise
